Removal of the Bitterroot Salish

Well, when we finally, our people were sent out of the Bitterroot, Old Lady Combs, Mary Ann Combs, she died in 1977, she was a relative of mine. I used to go visit her all the time. But she used to say, when they had to leave the Bitterroot, everybody was crying. This is in 1891 when the last bunch of Charlo's people had to leave. She said, "Everybody was crying, even the men." She said, "When we crossed the river to leave our homes."
